

PUDA to fill 194 vacancies

PUDA has initiated the process to fill 194 vacant posts of technical and non-technical cadres.

According to Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, minister in-charge, Department of Housing and Urban Development, Punjab, and vice-chairman of PUDA, revealed that the recruitment drive had been started after obtaining the required consent from Punjab Chief Minister Amarinder Singh, who is also the chairman of PUDA.

“Online applications have been invited for technical cadre posts which include sub-divi-

sional engineers (civil), sub-divisional engineers (public health), sub-divisional engineers (electrical), sub-divisional engineers (horticulture), junior engineers (civil), junior engineers (public health), junior engineers (electrical), junior engineers (horticulture), junior engineers (building), draftsman (engineering), draftsman (architect) and posts for non-technical cadres include law officers, senior assistant (accounts) and clerk-cum-data entry operators.

“Candidates will have to apply online and the process for registration will begin from July 9,” said Bajwa. — TNS
